UNDERSTANDING OUR LITURGY

Liturgy means "the work of the people." It is an ancient Greek word used theologically by St. Paul, but it was employed before him by Aristotle, who used it to describe the public work done on behalf of the city. Liturgy is public worship because it is the activity of the Church. Liturgy is thus communal, a gathering together of the members of the Church.

One image the Second Vatican Council used for the Church is the "Mystical Body of Christ." The Body of Christ refers to the Church and to the Eucharistic species. In receiving the Eucharistic species, members of the Church grow in deeper union with God and one another. What holds the Church together is the power and presence of Christ united to each of us. The liturgical act is a communal act performed by those united to one another and in deep communion with Christ as the Church, the Body of Christ.
