WHO IS THE NEW POPE LEO XIV?

First Pope from the United States. Pope Francis was from Argentina - South America. Pope Leo is not the first American Pope. Cardinal Robert Prevost has been elected as the first US-born pontiff and will be known as Pope Leo XIV. Leo made his first remarks as pope from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica in front of tens of thousands of onlookers, calling for peace and paying tribute to the late Pope Francis.

About the new pope: Leo, a 69-year-old from Chicago, is a leader with global experience. He spent much of his career as a missionary in South America and holds dual citizenship in the US and Peru, where he served as a bishop. He most recently led a powerful Vatican office for bishop appointments. He is expected to build on Pope Francis' reforms.

In his first words as Pope Francis' successor, uttered from the loggia of St. Peter's Basilica, Leo, 69, said, "Peace be with you," and emphasized a message of peace, dialogue and missionary evangelization. He wore the traditional red cape of the papacy — a cape that Francis had eschewed on his election in 2013.
