### FEASTS TODAY

#### The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ; June 18.

This feast honours the Body and Blood of Christ present in the *Blessed Sacrament*. It calls to mind the redemptive effects of the sacrament, and the fact that Jesus uses this sacrament to remain with us until the end of the world as he promised.

It was Bd. Juliana of Mount Cornillon (virgin, year 1258, April 5) who introduced the idea of a feast in honour of the Body and Blood of Christ. Born in the year 1192 in France, she grew up as a talented and gifted child. At the age of 16 years she began to have visions which asked for a special feast to honour the Blessed Sacrament. After she became a nun, she began suggesting this feast. Her bishop first celebrated it in the year 1246 in Liège, France. After her death in the year 1258, her work was taken up by the man who would become Pope Urban IV. St. Thomas Aquinas (priest & doctor, year 1274, March 7) composed the prayers for the feast. Pope Clement V made it universal in the year 1312.

### SAINTS THIS WEEK

#### St. Alban, first martyr of England, June 20.

Alban was a pagan, living in England, who gave shelter to a priest who was avoiding capture during the Roman persecutions in his area. So impressed was Alban, that he became a Christian. When the authorities came looking for the priest, Alban gave himself up in his place. Alban was beheaded, dying in the early third century.

His feast dates to about the year 540. *He is recognized as the first martyr in England.*

#### St. Aloysius Gonzaga, religious; June 21.

Aloysius was born in Italy in the year 1568. In the year 1585, he entered the training school for the Jesuits. He excelled in his studies, and was deeply involved with the poor and suffering. While assisting plague victims in Rome, he became infected, dying at the age of 23 years. He was still a seminarian at the time of his death.

He was canonized in the year 1726. He was named *patron saint of youth* by Pope Pius XI in the year 1926.

#### St. John Fisher, bishop & St. Thomas More, martyrs; June 22.

John Fisher was born in England, in the year 1469. Ordained a priest at the age of 25, then a bishop at the age of 35, he was well known for his wisdom. When he defended the validity of the first marriage of King Henry VIII, he was imprisoned in the year 1533. On June 22, 1535 he was beheaded for continuing to defend the work of the church.

Thomas More was born in England, in the year 1477. Receiving a good education, he became a member of parliament and a writer. He was made Chancellor of England by King Henry VIII, but he opposed the king's divorce, choosing to resign his position. After being imprisoned, he was beheaded on July 06, 1535.

They were canonized in the year 1935.

### FEASTS THIS WEEK

#### Sacred Heart of Jesus; June 23.

Celebrated on the Friday after the second Sunday after Pentecost, we recall that the blood and water which poured out when Jesus' side was pierced by the soldier's

lance are the price of our salvation, and the source of the sacraments in the Church.

St. Margaret Mary (virgin, year 1690, October 17) received several revelations from the Lord Jesus, asking that his heart be honoured under the form of a heart of flesh. These revelations began in the year 1673 while she was a Visitation nun in France. In the year 1675 her final revelation led Margaret to begin a campaign that would act against the ingratitude towards the goodness and mercy shown by the human race toward the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the year 1685 this feast began to be celebrated privately throughout France. In the year 1765 Pope Clement XIII authorized the Mass of the Sacred Heart, and in the year 1856 Pope Pius IX extended this feast to the entire Church.

#### Birth of John the Baptist; June 24.

John was the son of Zechariah, a priest in the Jewish law; and of Elizabeth, a cousin to the Blessed Virgin Mary. His upcoming birth had been announced to Zechariah by an angel. Prompted by the angel's visit to her, Mary came to visit her cousin giving rise to the feast of the visitation (May 31).

The birth of John was originally celebrated as part of the Epiphany, then from the late fourth century, on June 24, six months before the birth of Jesus.
