SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION SATURDAY, DECEMBER 6, 11:00am

Confirmation is an essential part of Christian Initiation. In Confirmation the bishop seals us, the baptized, with the Gift of the Holy Spirit. This sacrament is intended to:

- root us more deeply as sons and daughters of God,
- incorporate us more firmly into Christ,
- strengthen our bond with the Church,
- associate us more closely with the mission of the Church, and strengthen us to bear witness to the Christian faith.

CHRIST THE KING SOLEMNITY November 23, 2025.

- Christ's kingship is not worldly: Jesus' kingdom is founded on love, truth, and justice, not on worldly power, conquest, or wealth.
- Hope in a time of hardship: Christ's kingship provides an anchor of hope, particularly when facing difficult and painful situations in our lives and the world.
- A call to serve: The Feast of Christ the King invites us to follow his example by serving others, such as feeding the hungry and caring for the sick, rather than seeking to be served.
- Letting go of our own "kingdoms": The Jubilee theme encourages a spiritual reset, which involves surrendering our self-made ambitions and "kingdoms" to embrace God's kingdom of love and community.
- Mercy and forgiveness: The Jubilee offers an opportunity to experience God's boundless mercy, which flows from the heart of Christ, and to become a source of mercy for others.
