### Pastor Reflects...

May you continue to experience the love GOD has for you, especially as demonstrated in the life, ministry, teaching, example, death, and resurrection of Jesus and may you model that love in your concern for others.

We have all heard of philanthropists. Those are people who demonstrate a loving concern for others usually by making donations of money to charities. It comes from two Greek words: φιλια (philia - love of duty and relationship) and ανθρωρος (anthropos - human). The word implies that the philanthropist is a true humanist (which is positive but may imply that person is gaining something from their acts, such as a tax break or recognition from others).

I thought the word "agapist" is a better word. I did a little research and found that there is a website called "agapist." I also found the definition of "agapism" in Wikipedia. Both words come from the Greek word αγαπη (agape) which means "unconditional love" or that type of love GOD has for each human. It is a total, selfless love. Its focus is on the other person. It is distinguished from other Greek words for love which are positive, but have a certain self-interest involved. We are called to love with αγαπη (agape) love – totally unconditional love for another.

Mother's do this so well. We thank all Mother's today, and pray God's Love to each of them. We commend to God's Love and Mercy all those Mothers' who have been called home to the Father's House. Happy Mother's Day! Hug the "Mother" in your life, if you can...

We have made some cut backs and reduced expenses as best we can. Voluntarily reductions in salary from pastor and staff have also taken place.

# PRE- REGISTRATION FOR MASS AND COMMUNION SERVICES

Please call or email the parish office before each Thursday at Noon to schedule for any Mass or Communion Service you wish to attend. We are only allowed to accommodate 10 people which includes the priest.

Some have recently pre-registered and then didn't show up. No notice was given of not being able to attend. Some have developed a habit of doing this. We cannot allow this to continue. Therefore, those individuals cannot pre-register until the lockdown is over.

Communion Services are offered this week in order to accommodate more people to receive the Eucharist. Opening and close prayers, readings of the day, Our Father, Holy Communion. We encourage you to attend weekday Mass. You, don't have to wait until Sunday.
