

UPCOMING SOLEMNITIES

May 31st is the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, celebrating Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth. This feast commemorates the event described in the Gospel of Luke where Mary, pregnant with Jesus, visits Elizabeth, who is also pregnant with John the Baptist. The feast day was established by Pope Urban VI in 1389 and is a time for prayer and reflection on Mary's role in the salvation story.

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord commemorates Jesus' bodily ascension into heaven, 40 days after his Resurrection. It signifies the completion of his earthly mission and his exaltation, now seated at the right hand of the Father, guiding the Church through the Holy Spirit. This feast serves as a reminder of our own call to "ascend" with Christ, embracing a life of faith and love, ultimately leading to a heavenly union with God.

Pentecost reflection is a time to consider the gift of the Holy Spirit and how it empowers us to live a life of love, forgiveness, and service. It's a time to reflect on the transformative power of the Holy Spirit, as seen in the early church's experience on the day of Pentecost, and to consider how that same Spirit can empower us today to be agents of change in the world.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin."

Corpus Christi also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a feast that honours Jesus Christ, Really, Truly and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance") when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in remembrance of me." In 2025 the Solemnity of Corpus Christi is on June 19, but it is transferred to Sunday June 25 in some diocese.
