POPE LEO'S INTENTIONS FOR JULY

For the formation in discernment, specifically that we may learn to choose paths of life that lead us away. He asks for guidance from the Holy Spirit in making these choices and encourages attentiveness to God's voice.

Discernment:

This refers to the ability to distinguish between what is good and what is not, especially in the context of making decisions that affect our spiritual life.

Choosing the right path:

The Pope is asking for prayers to help individuals make choices that align with the teaching of Christ and the Gospel, leading closer to God.

Rejecting what leads away:

This involves recognizing and resisting temptations of influences that draw us away from God and towards sin.

Guidance of the Holy Spirit:

The Pope acknowledges that discernment is a process guided by the Holy Spirit, and he is praying for this divine assistance.

Attentiveness to God's voice:

He emphasizes the importance of listening to God's gentle and Subtle guidance in our daily lives.
